About Our Camps

The camp site is a safe and serene environment filled with greenery, flowers, and trees, a full baseball field, soccer field, basketball and handball courts, a reading park, and play structures. There is ample room for riding bikes, scooters, skating and water play. There is an art studio, computer lab, theater, rehearsal rooms, workshop facilities, a cooking kitchen and library.

The staff, both senior and junior, are dedicated to respecting the individual uniqueness of the camper and providing an amicable environment for growing and learning. We believe that the academic studies of the school year are actualized and applied in summer months through creativity, free play, and socialization with one's peers. Our goal is simple: provide a safe, happy, family-like place for summer fun, personal growth, and new friendships.

PEACE CAMP

The Peace Camp is designed for play, relaxation, personal fitness, and creative development. We provide a comprehensive visual arts program, a skill-honing, non-competitive sports program and a personal reading program daily. Other weekly workshops include cooking, drama, science, voice, dance, word games, sewing, clothes design, mock court, arts and crafts, gardening, and gymnastics (mat and low beam only). Bikes, scooters and skates are big at this camp (helmets are a must!) There are also special events throughout the summer, i.e. The Luau, The Carnival, The Tribes Game and D.J. Dances. This camp is good for children who like to develop themselves in a lot of different activities on a daily basis and are not interested in a specialty camp.

MUSICAL THEATER CAMP

FUN IN THE SUN: PRE-K CAMP

This camp is all about developing a comfort zone for children who are about to enter kindergarten. It includes a morning talking circle, academic introduction, art and crafts, campus acclimation, developing kindergarten leadership and creating the Kindergarten garden. A Community Magnet Kindergarten teacher is on staff for these weeks. Parents are welcome to stay if they like.

COOKING CAMP

This camp will start with the basics of cooking and continue through to full meal preparation, including table etiquette and centerpiece design. Book recipes, as well as, cooking by eye and smell will be taught. Nutritional balance and the importance of the colors of food on a plate will be investigated as we proceed with the full dinner courses.

Hours: 9:00 AM—2:00 PM

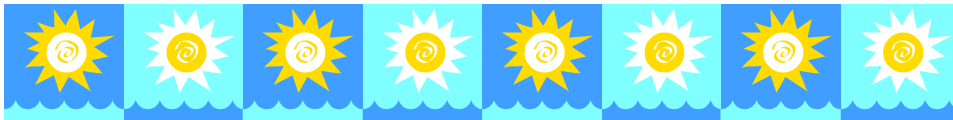
COUNSELOR IN TRAINING PROGRAM

This program is designed for youth interested in developing their leadership and work ethic skills. All participants will be assigned to assist in workshops that fall into their special interest. CAMP POLICIES

Sign Out: The law requires parents to sign their children out. Your child will not be released to anyone not listed on the emergency contact list. If you need to have your child/children picked up by someone NOT included on the list, we require BOTH a telephone call from you and a written authorization. Appropriate identification will be required.

Absences: Because our expenses are fixed, we cannot give credits or make-up days for the absence of your child. We pay staff, custodial services, etc. whether your child is absent or not.

Tardiness in picking up children: We provide a ten-minute grace period after our 6:00 PM closing time. After this grace period the late fee is \$20 and is to be paid directly to the staff present.

At 6:45 PM, the staff will make every effort to reach you or your emergency contacts. If we are unable to make an authorized contact, your child/children will be taken to the local police station, as stated by law. Children are not allowed to be taken by the staff. You will also be responsible for paying additional late fines.
